The European Union



The European Union (EU) was formed to bring together the countries of Europe. The EU helps its member countries with issues such as trade, security, and the rights of citizens.

In June 2016, 52% of the British public voted to leave the EU. Britain had to negotiate a deal and they eventually left on 31st January 2020 under Boris Johnson's leadership.
